



# 2<sup>nd</sup> HIGH-TECH SUMMIT FOR THE BLACK SEA

16.10.2024 Sofia, BULGARIA

**The High-Tech Summit for the Black Sea (HTS4BS)**, funded under H2020 BRIDGEBS, is a significant research-based forum focused on ocean digitalization and Industry 4.0. It brings together blue economy innovators from the Black Sea region and beyond, fostering dialogue among industry members, academia, research organizations, investors, policymakers, and civil society.

The first edition took place in Varna, Bulgaria in September 2022, and the second edition is scheduled for Sofia, Bulgaria on the 16 October 2024 with in person attendance.

Building on BRIDGE-BS first outcomes as well as local and regional stakeholders' inputs, the event will showcase business ideas supported by the **Black Sea Accelerator**, with discussions spanning from renewable maritime energy, sustainable aquaculture, blue biotech, green and digital ports, yachting, circular economy, environmental monitoring, and marine security. Interactive sessions will facilitate business idea presentations, projects and matchmaking with partners and investors.

There will be interactive sessions offering opportunities for showcasing business ideas, projects and matchmaking with partners and investors.

The event will also be an occasion to showcase the business ideas supported by the **Black Sea Accelerator**, promoted in cooperation with the DOORS project, and to host some pitching sessions for those ideas towards international sustainable investors, while awarding those deemed to have a greater impact and those who made a greater improvement throughout the acceleration support.

Additionally, to maximize synergies with other relevant actions in the Black Sea, 2<sup>nd</sup> HTS4BS is organized back-to-back with the **Horizon Europe Sustainable Blue Economy Partnership (SBEP) Black Sea Regional Workshop** that will take place on 17 October in the same venue.
